# Hartford Foundation Awards More Than \$350,000 in First Round of Basic Human Needs Emergency Assistance Grants

When people are unable to afford food and other basic necessities, it's difficult to do anything else. Kids can't perform to their best ability in school and adults can't focus on work. That's why the Hartford Foundation is committed to supporting basic human needs in our region — because it lays the foundation for success in all other areas of our work.

Earlier this month, we announced a series of **44 grants totaling more than \$350,000 to support basic human needs** in Greater Hartford. The nonprofits receiving these grants provide vital services including food assistance, personal care items, emergency case management, emergency financial assistance and more. The critical work being done by these nonprofits will help prevent residents from losing their jobs or
