










LATINOS IN THE GREATER HARTFORD REGION

Based on data from state departments of Labor and Economic and Community Development, population growth is projected to grow just 1.7% in the 25 years from 2015 to 2040.




In contrast, growth of the Latino population is expected to account for approx. 64% of the total growth in the Connecticut population over a 10-year period from 2015-2025.

Change in population by race: Connecticut, 2010-2050
















EARNED INCOME GROWTH FOR FT WORKERS









HOW MUCH LARGER WOULD THE ECONOMY BE WITH RACIAL EQUITY
















HOME OWNERSHIP


