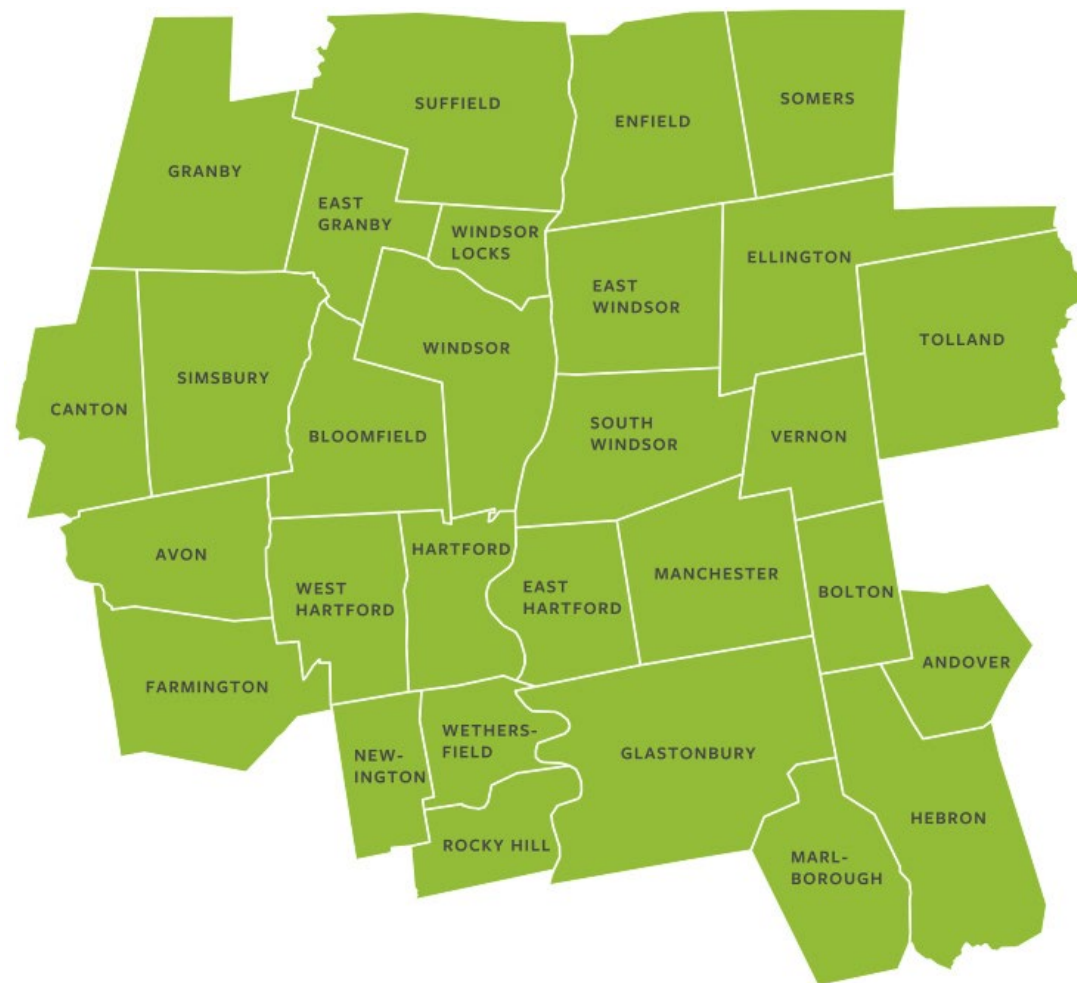

Connecticut population in 2022 is estimated to be 3.61 million and ranks 29<sup>th</sup> most populous state

The median age for Connecticut Latinos is 29.3 Years

## Latino Population Growth

Between 2010 & 2021, Latino population had the most growth increasing by 154,711 from 482,401 in 2010 to 637,112 in 2021

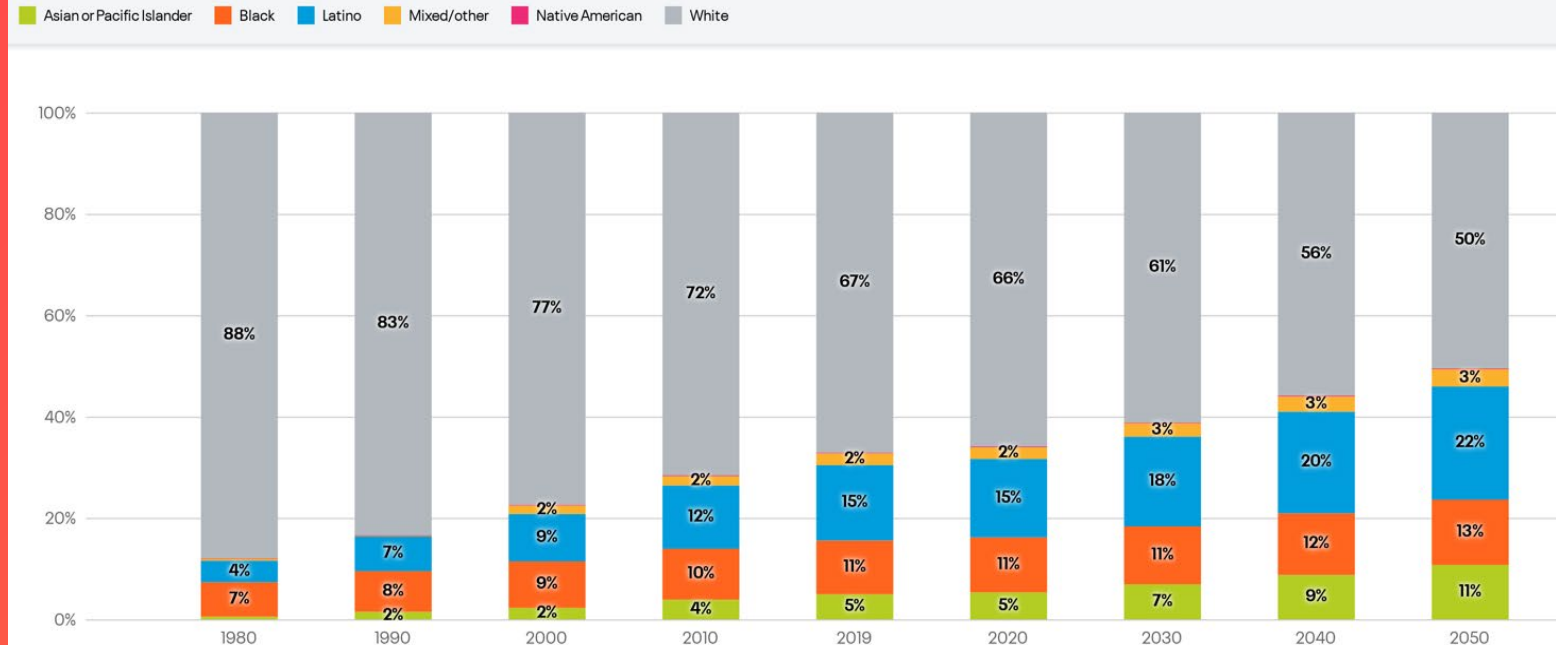

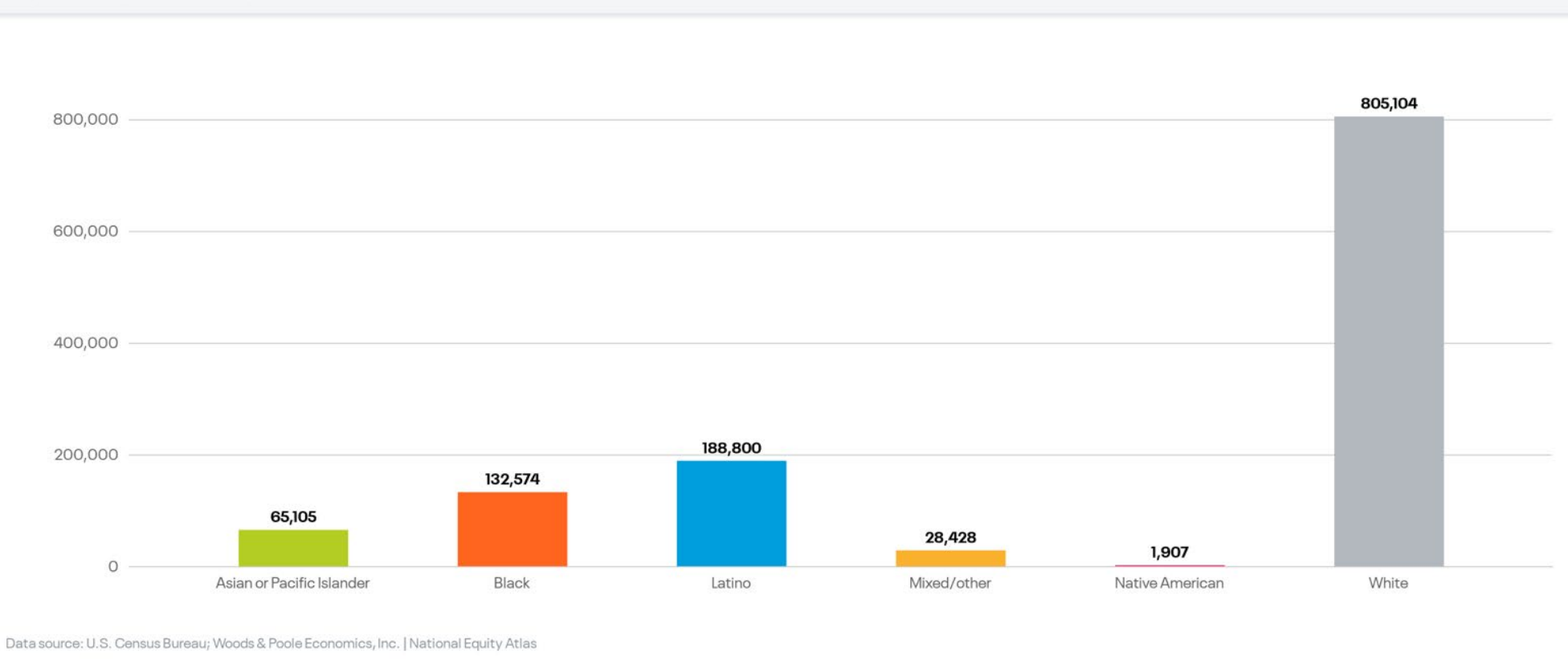

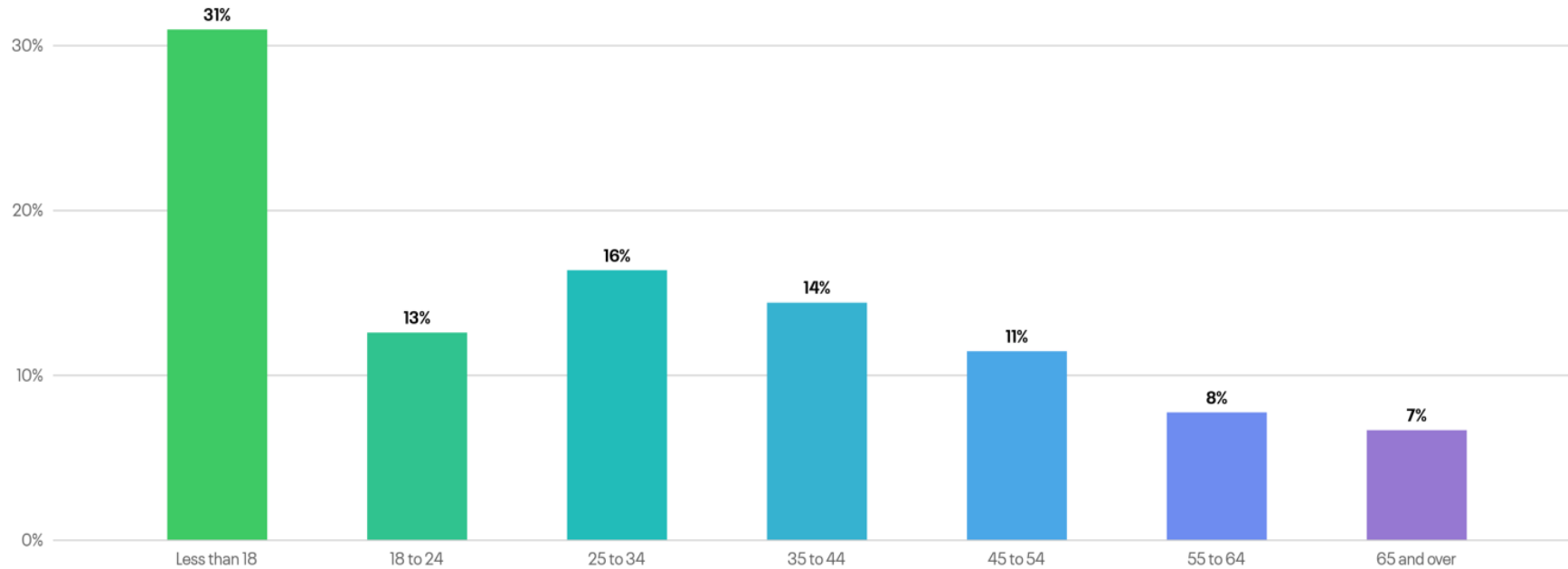


Population by race/ethnicity: Hartford-West Hartford-East Hartford, CT; Year: 2020

# LATINOS IN THE GREATER HARTFORD REGION



Based on data from state departments of Labor and Economic and Community Development, **population growth** is projected to grow just 1.7% in the 25 years from 2015 to 2040.



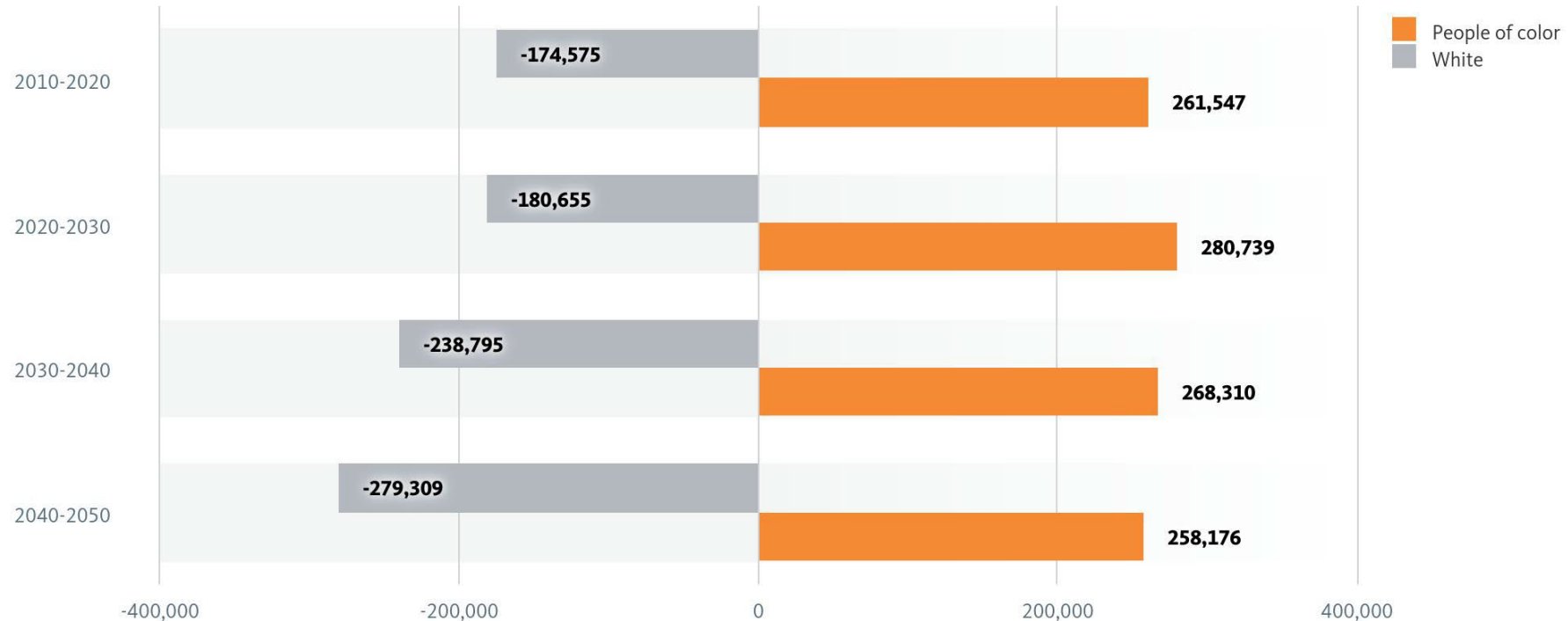
In contrast, **growth of the Latino population** is expected to account for approx. 64% of the total growth in the Connecticut population over a 10-year period from 2015-2025.

Change in population by race: Connecticut, 2010-2050



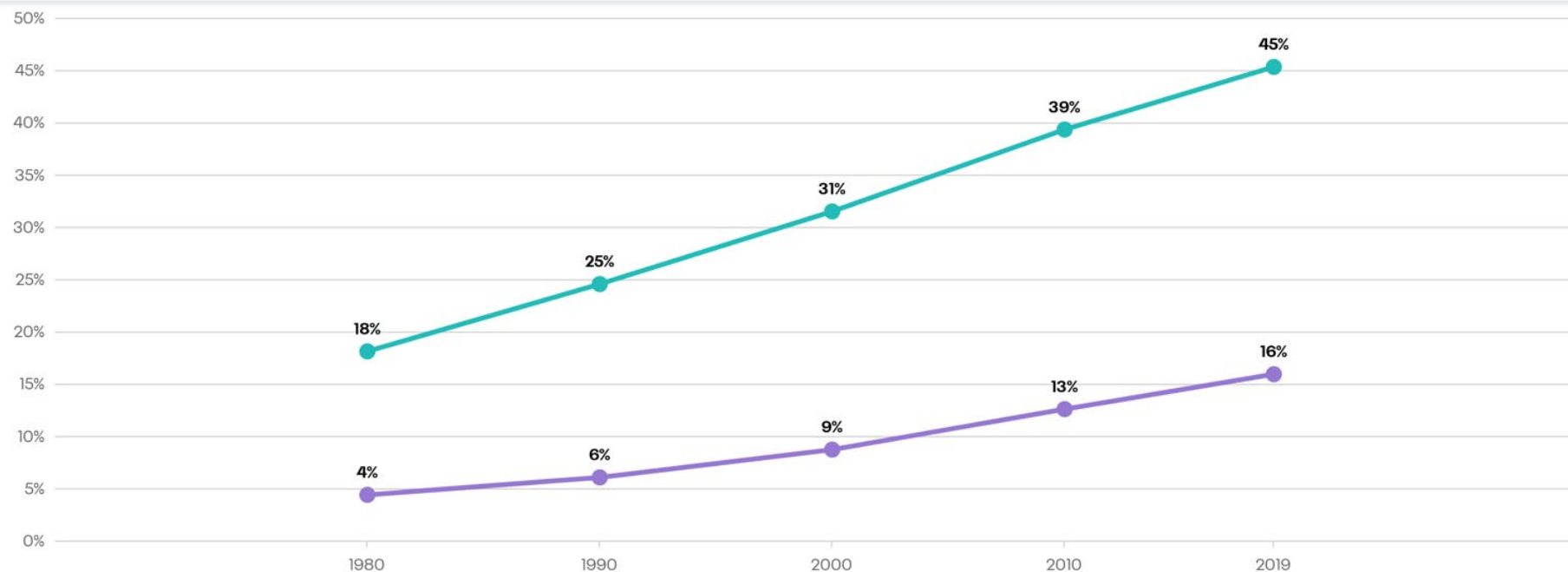

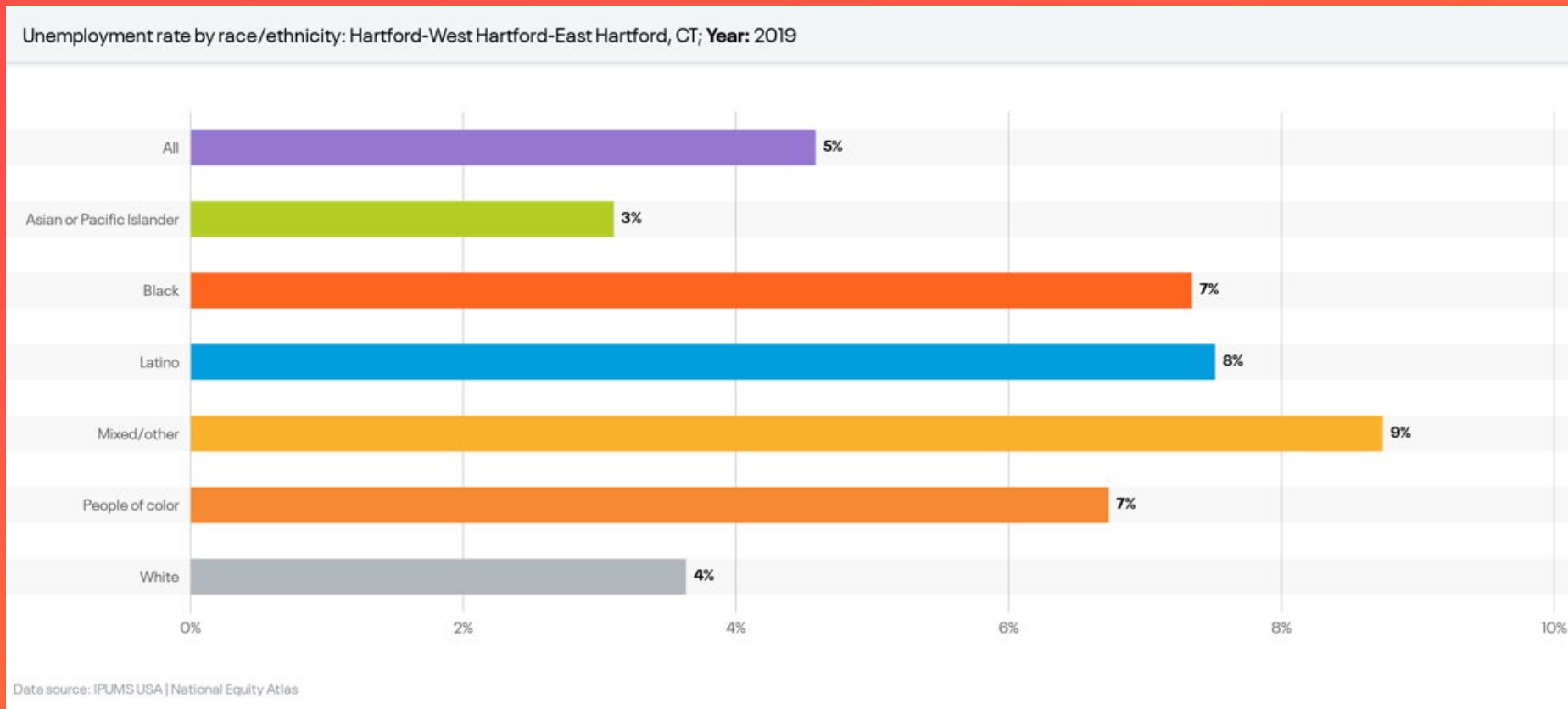

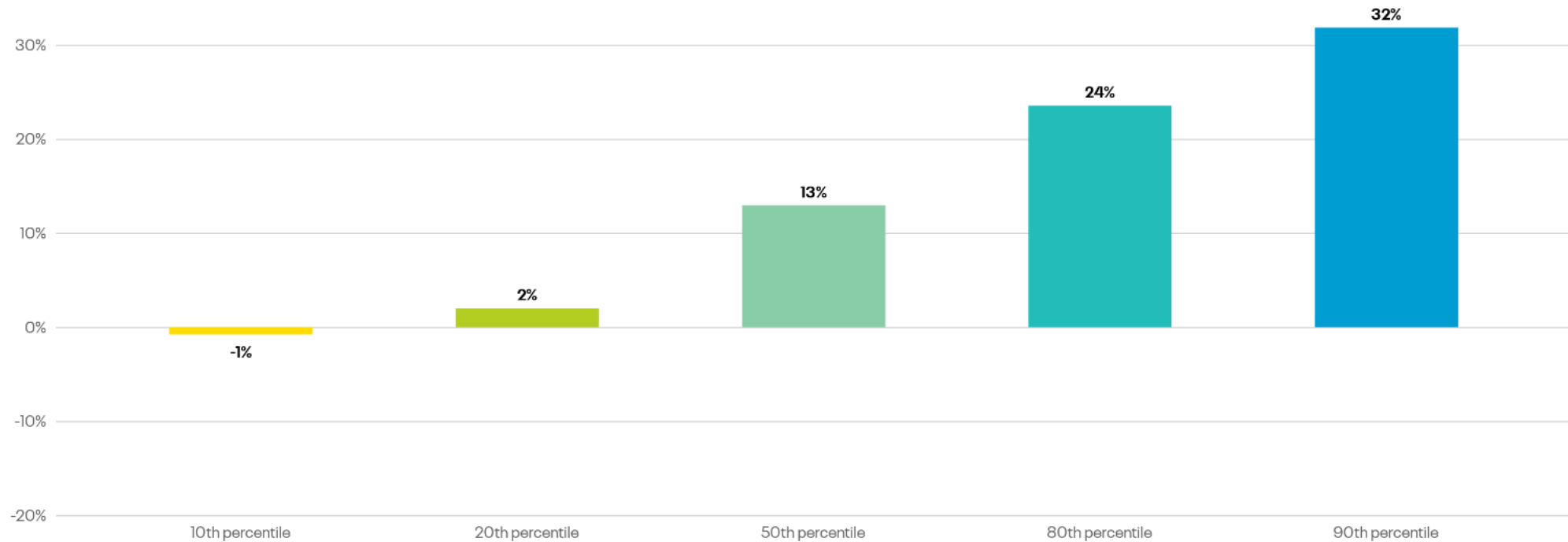




# EARNED INCOME GROWTH FOR FT WORKERS

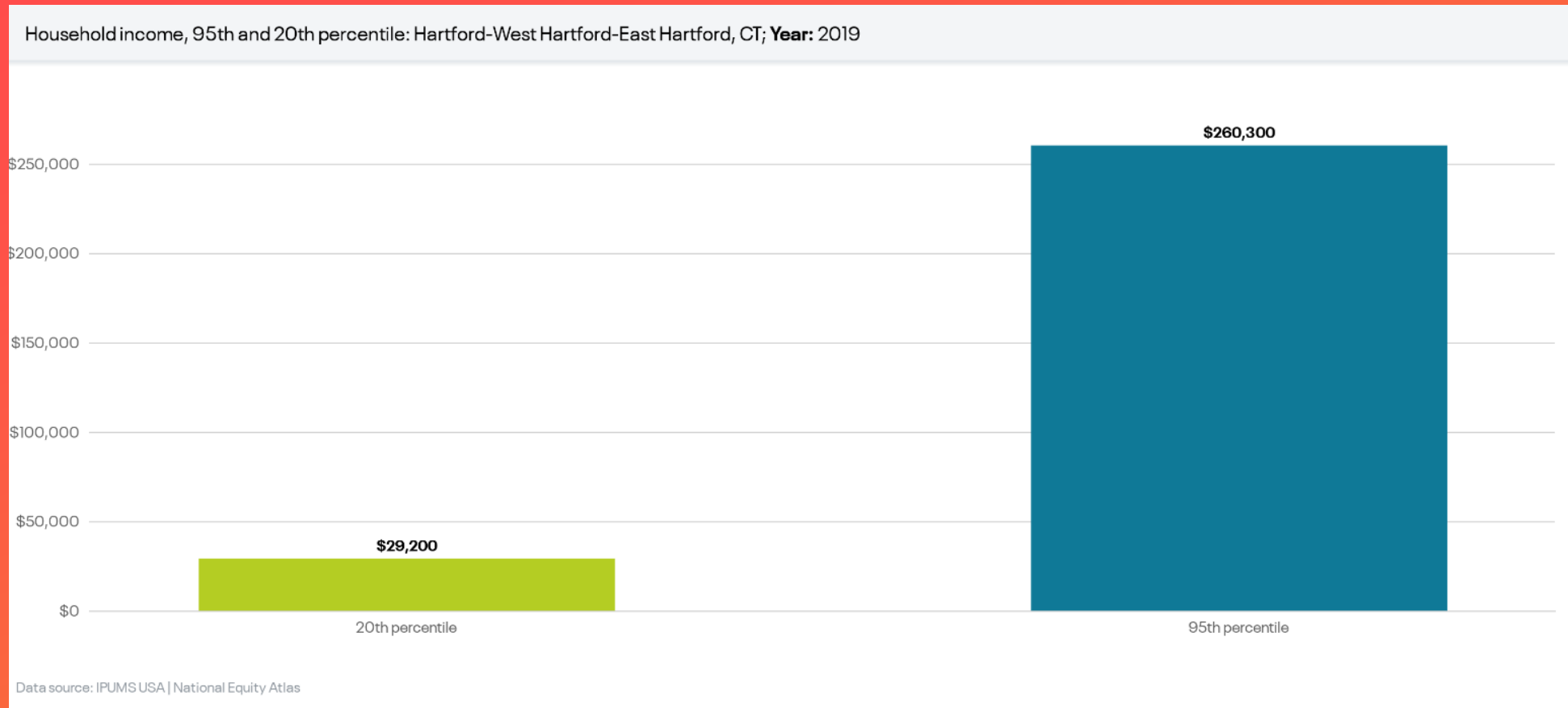


Earned income growth for full-time wage and salary workers: Hartford-West Hartford-East Hartford, CT; Years: 1980-2019

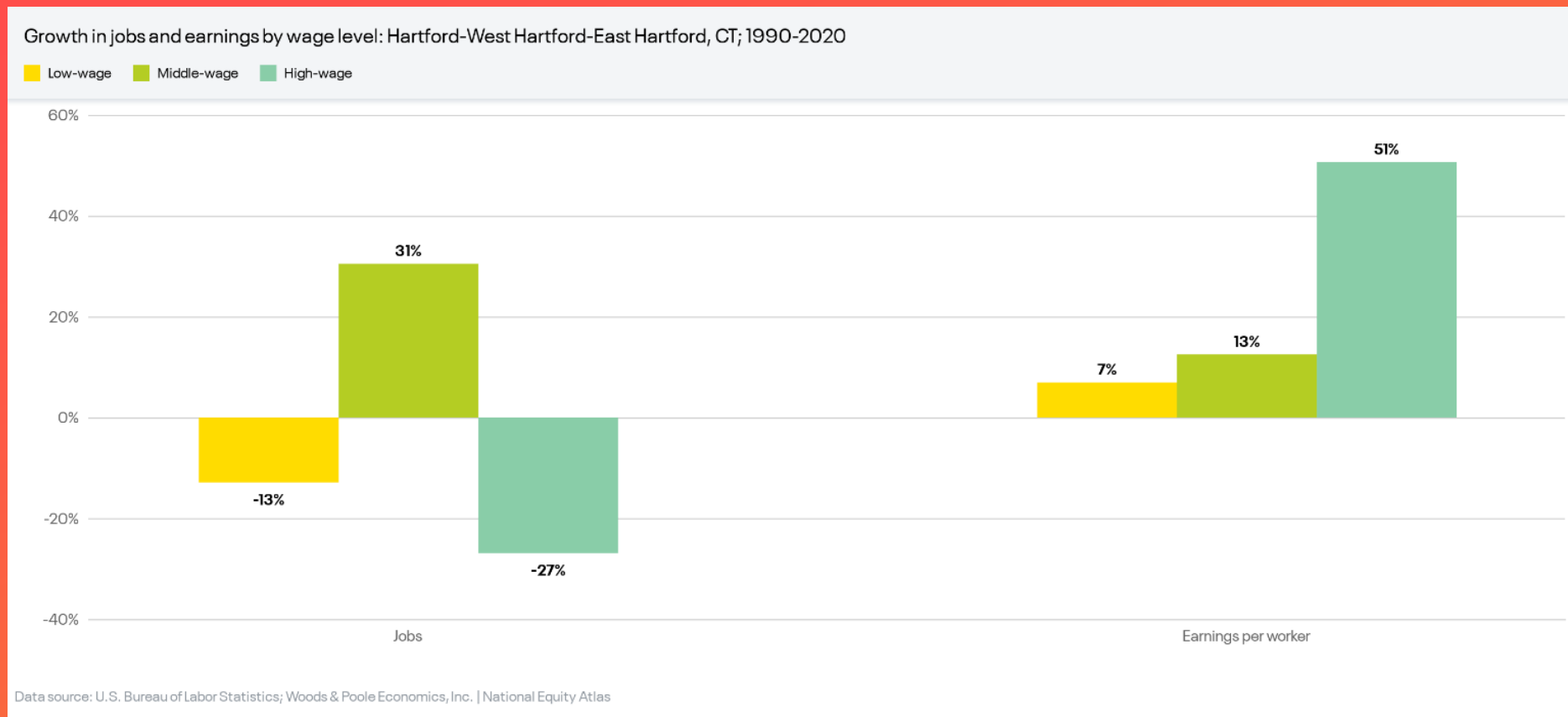

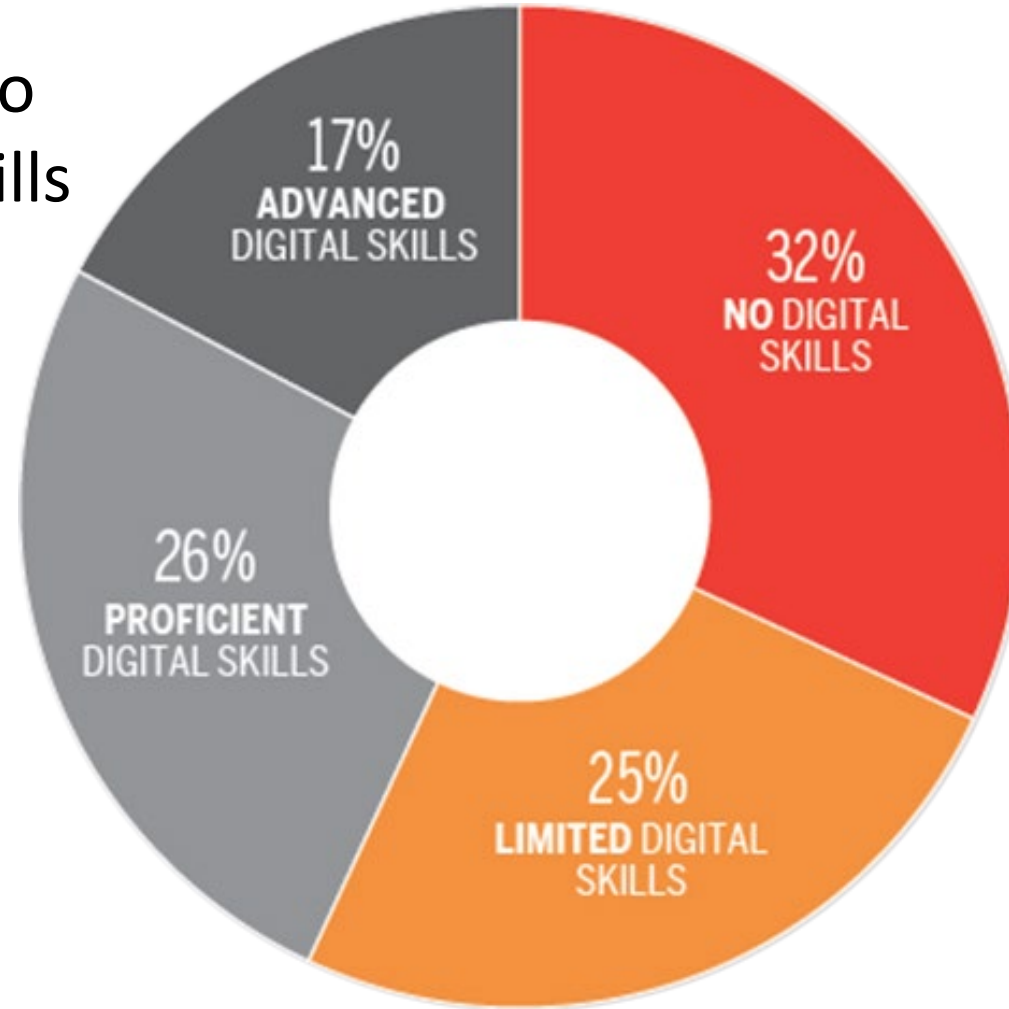

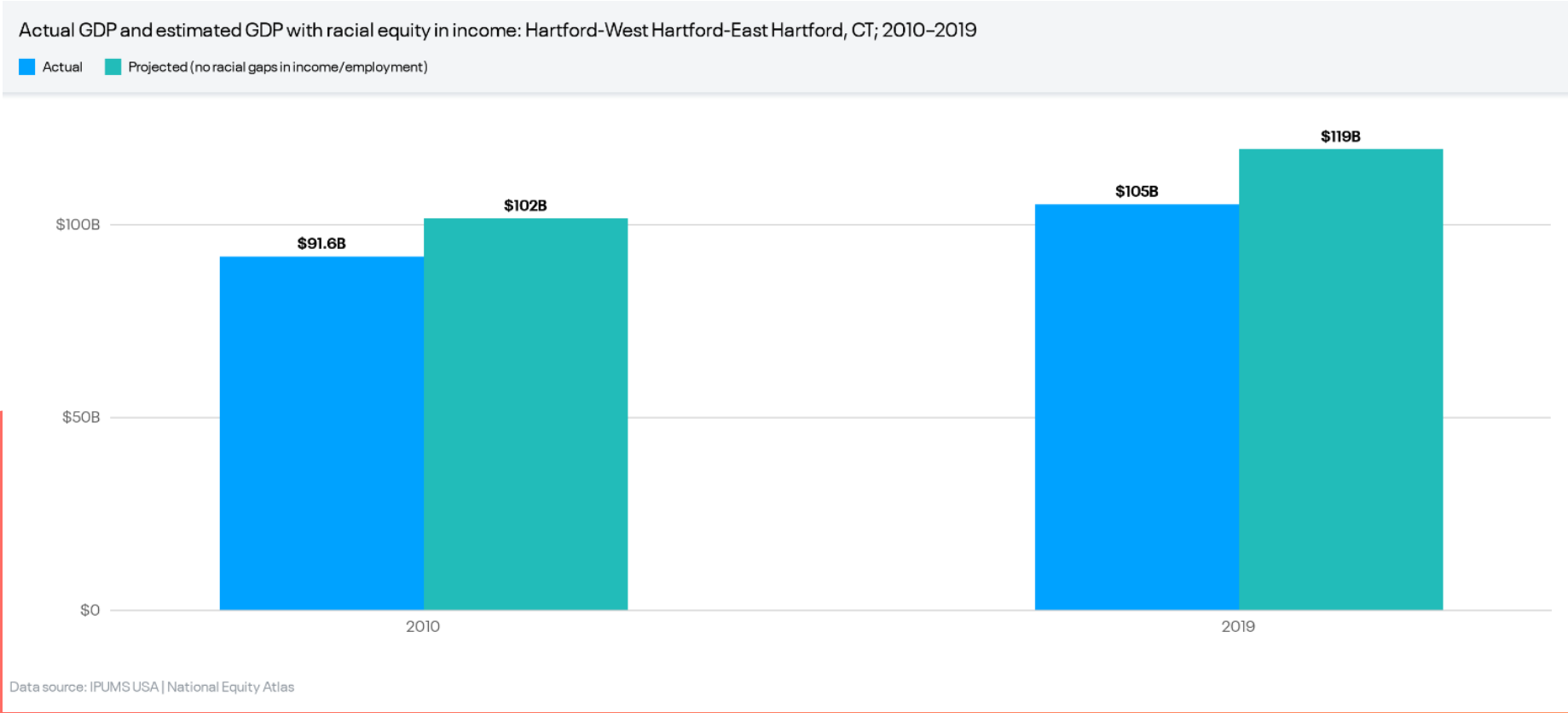

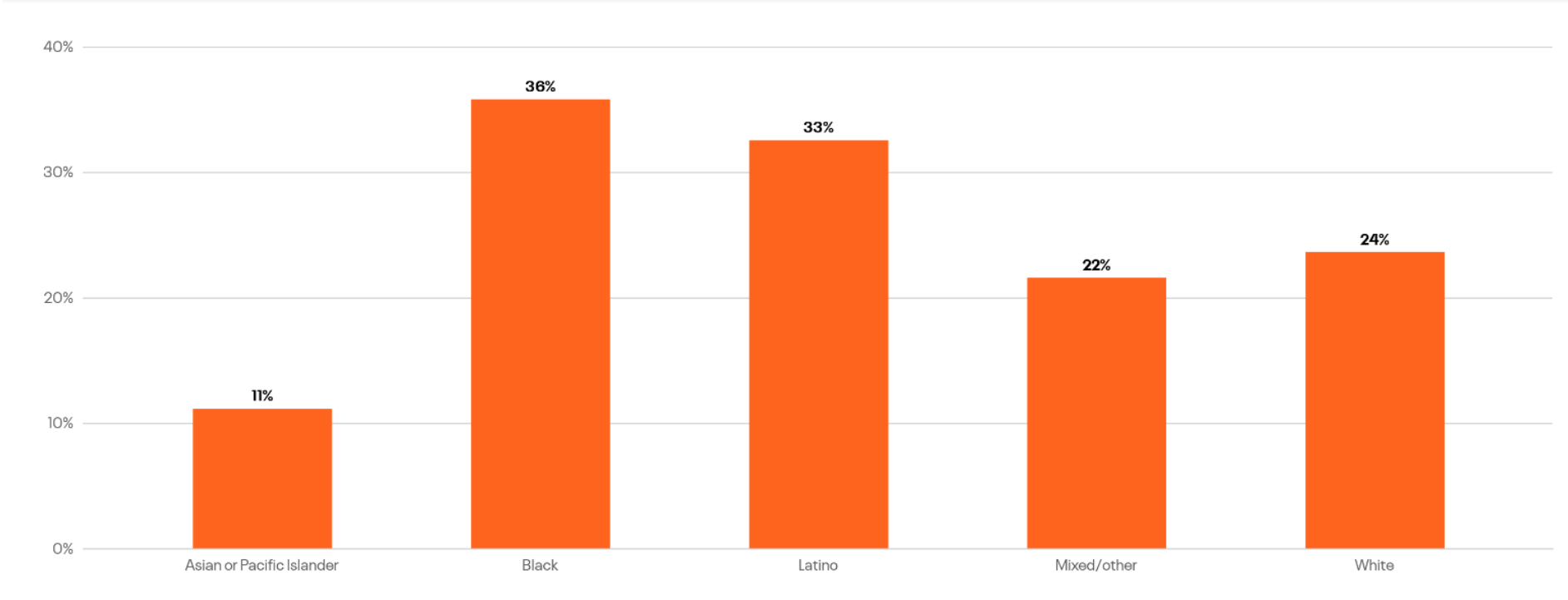
# HOW MUCH LARGER WOULD THE ECONOMY BE WITH RACIAL EQUITY





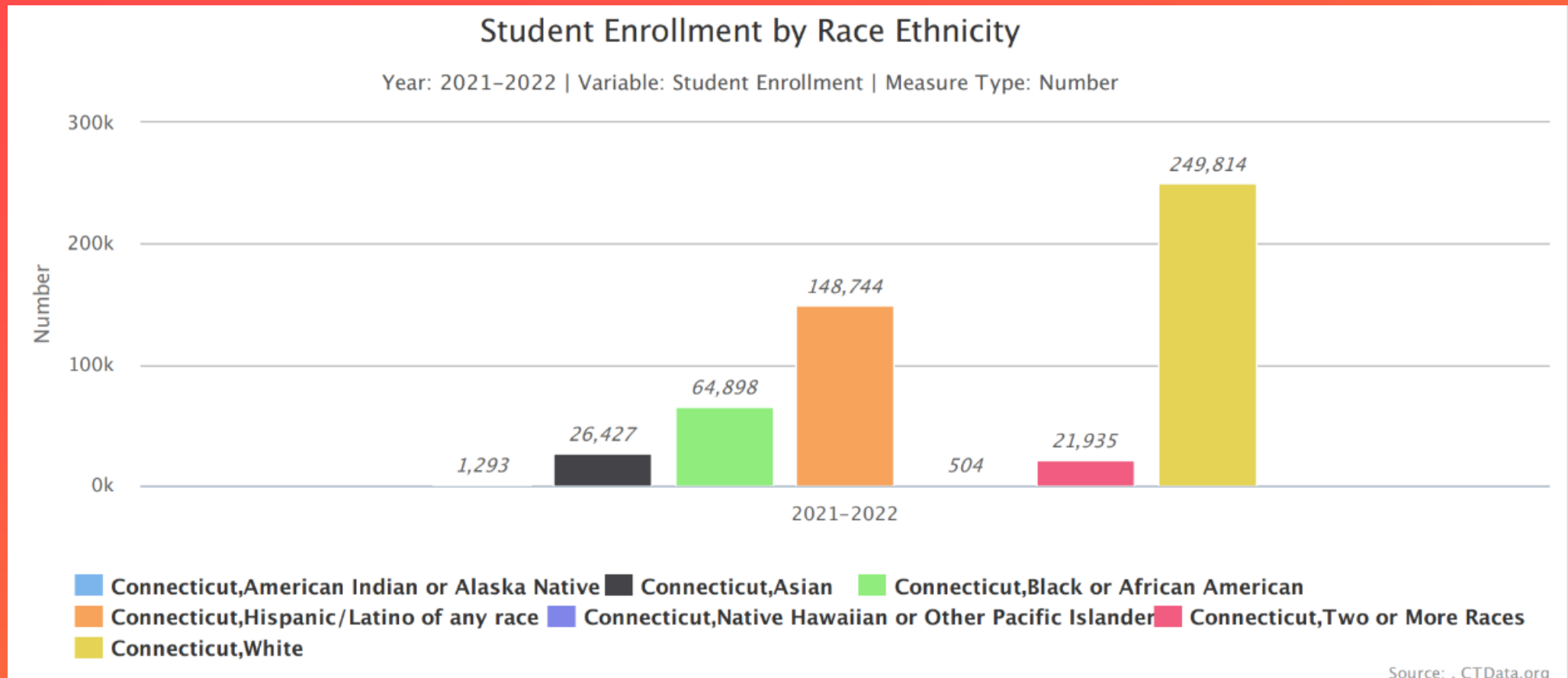

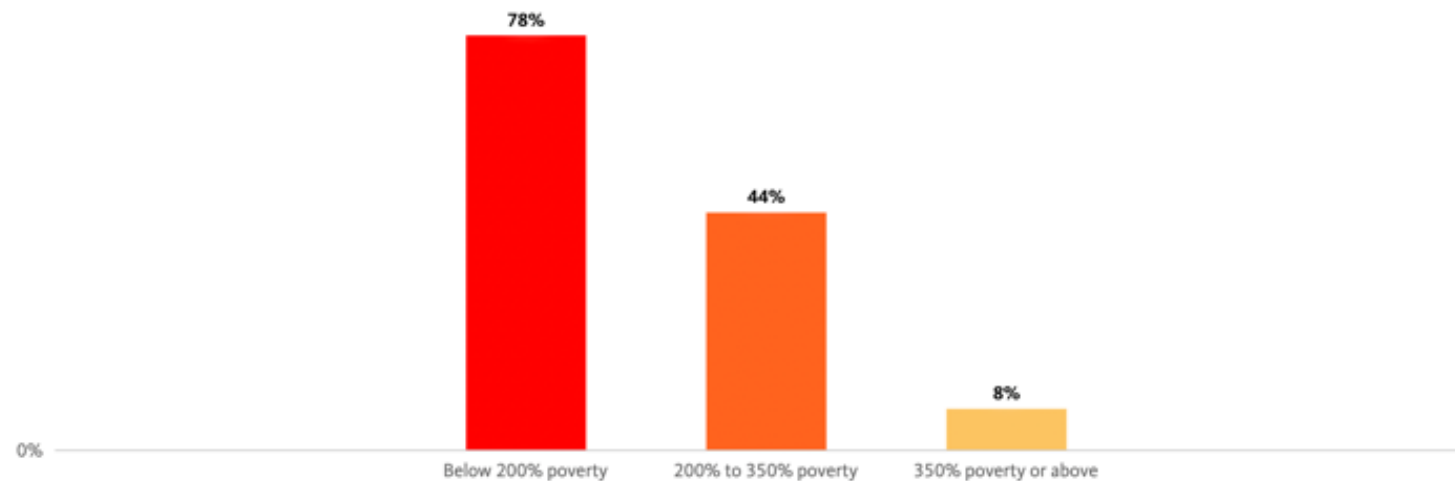

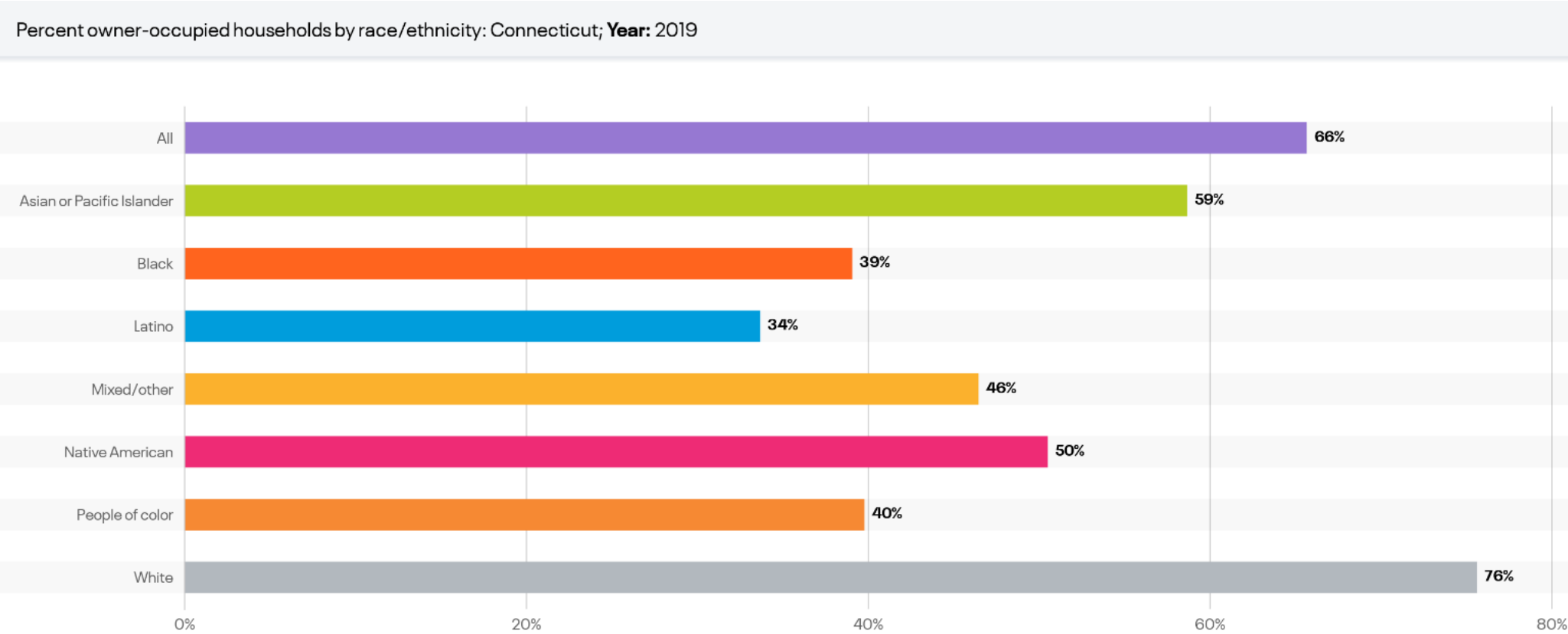

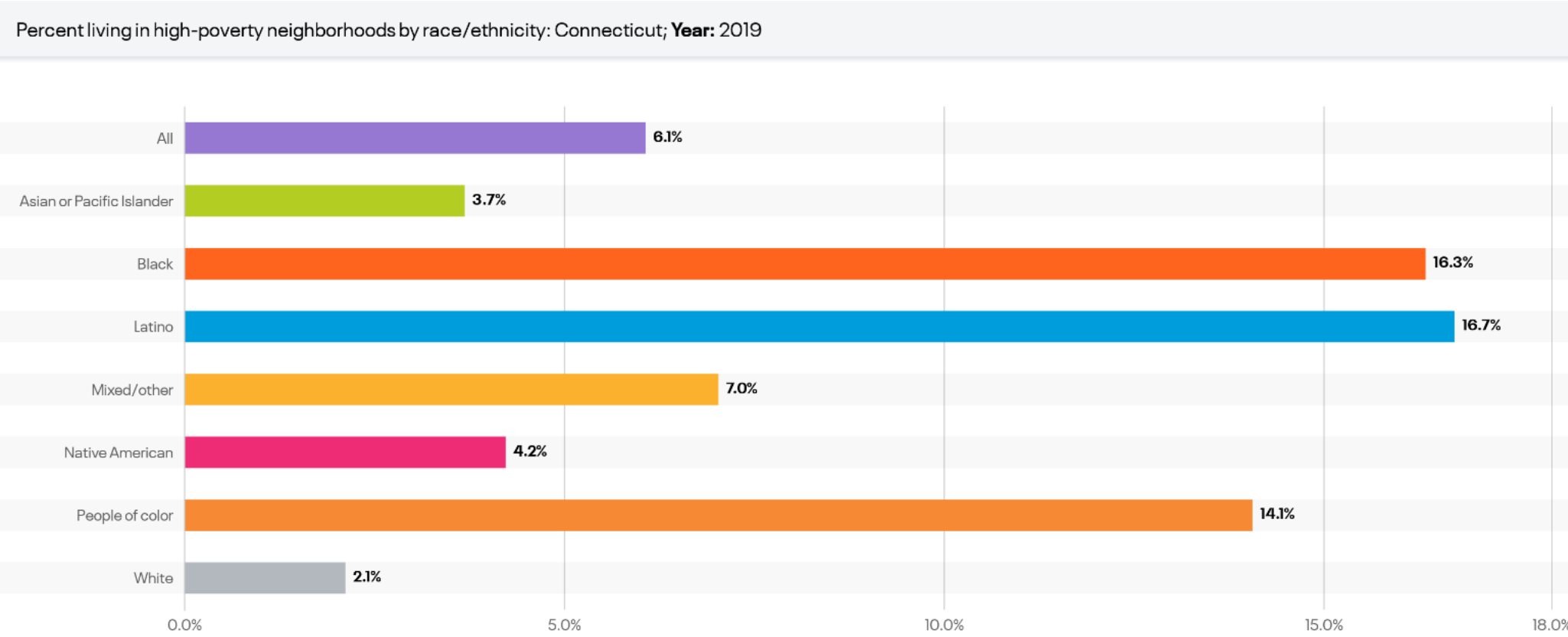

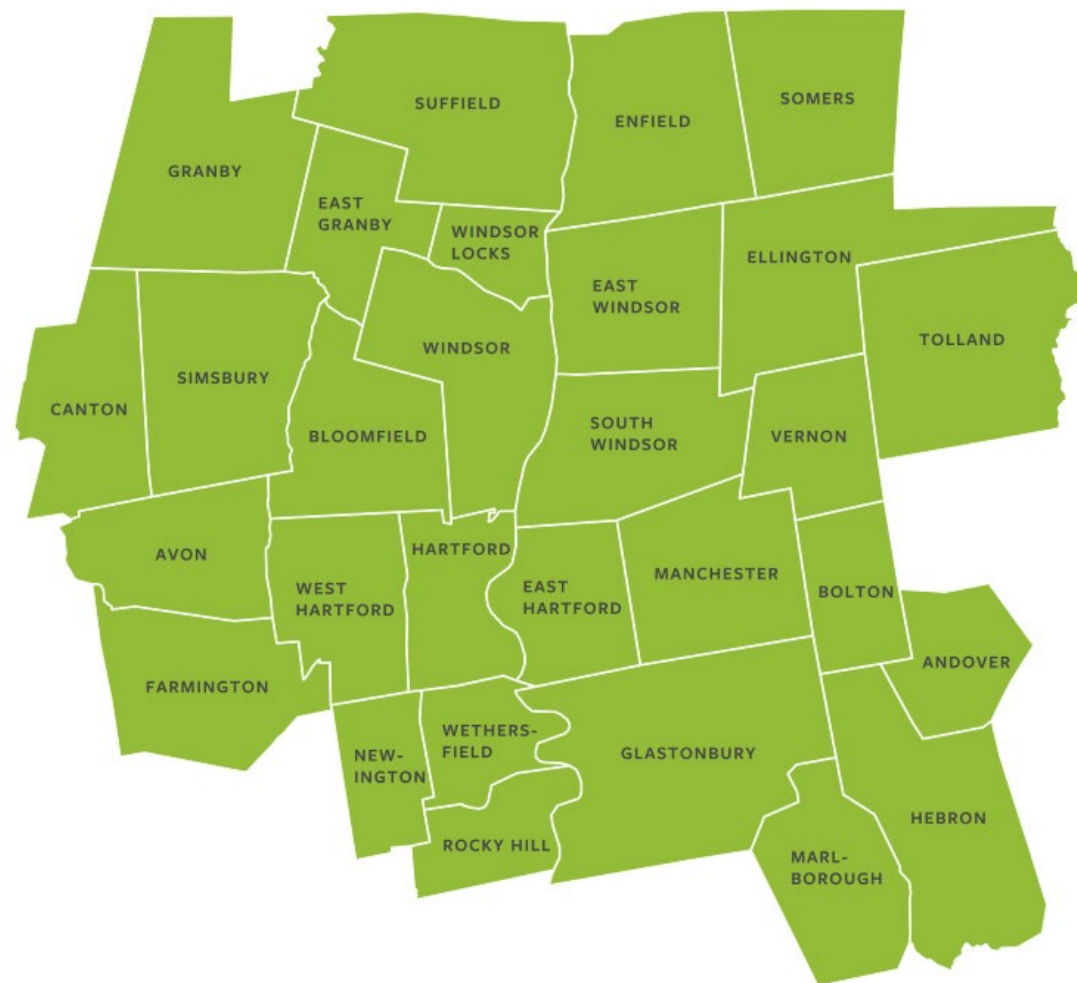
