Convenant to Care Awarded \$3,000!



Mission: To provide a safety net for abused, neglected or impoverished children in Connecticut by providing essential support in moments that are critical for a child's ability to thrive and a family's ability to stay together.

Program Funded:

Grant funds will be used to provide basic essential and/or mandated goods specifically for Farmington, Connecticut children, birth to 18, who are abused, neglected, impoverished and/or otherwise at-risk. Items include: car seats, beds, cribs, furniture, clothing, other household goods, school uniforms, maternity supplies and toddler equipment to meet the urgent needs of children who are at risk of being removed from their home or in the process of being reunited with their caregiver(s).

Most of these families have limited financial resources and are living at or below the poverty level. During a home visit, a social worker will notice that children are living in a high-risk environment and lack basic, essential goods like a bed or crib. CCC provides these items so that children can be healthy, safe, smart and strong children.
